Pathways to Promise was formed in 1988 to enable faith communities to become leaders in reaching out to people with mental illness and their families. It was created to promote full inclusion of people who have a mental illness and their families, empowering them for mutual and interactive participation in their faith communities. Pathways has the goal of being a catalyst for action in the faith community that enhances the quality of life for those challenged by mental illness.

Pathways is a resource center offering:

- ⌘ Liturgical and educational materials
- ⌘ Program models
- ⌘ Networking information to promote a caring ministry with people with mental illness and their families.
- ⌘ Assistance to laity and lay organizations interested in educating themselves about working with the faith community

Pathways is committed to creating an atmosphere in the faith and mental health communities which enables cooperative and coordinated activities such as educational and service programs.

Available Resources

Pathways education resources are used in congregations, faith group staff events, seminary course work, continuing education events, regional and national denominational events, and other settings that heighten an understanding and sensitivity in the faith community to the needs of people with a mental illness and their families.
